It equips participants with accurate, age-appropriate information in six subject areas: human development, relationships, personal skills, sexual behavior, sexual health, and society and culture. Grounded in a holistic view of sexuality, *Our Whole Lives* provides not only facts about anatomy and human development, but helps participants to clarify their values, build interpersonal skills, and understand the spiritual, emotional, and social aspects of sexuality.

Each level of *Our Whole Lives* offers:

- Up-to-date information and honest, age-appropriate answers to all participants' questions
- Activities to help participants clarify values and improve decision-making skills
- Effective group building to create a safe and supportive peer group
- Education about sexual abuse, exploitation, and harassment
- Opportunities to critique media messages about gender and sexuality
- Acceptance of diversity
- Encouragement to act for justice

Registration Information: Pairs are required to lead OWL, preferably of different genders. Registration includes home hospitality, meals, snacks, and materials for participants only. Home hospitality is *guaranteed* for those registering by the deadline. Home hospitality for late registrants *may* be available up to one week before the training. A 50% deposit is required to hold your place. No phone registrations will be accepted. You will receive registration confirmation following the deadline. Childcare is not available; occasional visits by a nursing baby may be acceptable. Maximum number of participants is 24. If there are less than 12 registrants by the deadline, the training may be canceled. After the deadline registration is accepted as space permits. If the registration is full, preference is given to teams from the Pacific Northwest District and Conference.

Refund Policy: All cancellations prior to the registration deadline will be subject to a \$15.00 handling charge. Cancellations after the deadline will be subject to a \$30.00 fee, unless a replacement is arranged. (Check with Registrar for waiting list information). Cancellations within one day or no-show may forfeit entire fee dependent on funds available at the end of the training. However, if the minimum requirement of 12 participants is not registered by April 15 then all fees will be returned in full.
